Tie GyanYin

Tie Guan Yin is one of the most famous and premium Chinese oolong teas. It was created early in the Qing Dynasty in Anxi, Fujian Province. This tea is characterized by a smooth, refreshing and slightly sweet flavour.

Green Mint

This is a delicious and invigorating tea which combines the delightful strength of China gunpowder tea with the intense sweetness and aroma of premium peppermint leaves to create a well-balanced and stimulating tea which will awaken all the senses.

White Apricot

A truly refreshing tea which combines white tea with apricot pieces, marigold flowers and yellow rose buds. The combination of sweet apricot with hints of marigold and rose creates a delightfully tasty white tea which can also be drunk as an iced tea.

Very Berry

This is a truly delicious and refreshing fruit infusion which produces a deep red cup with sweet berry and slightly sour hibiscus undertones. This tea contains a variety of dried fruit ingredients and is a must for all berry lovers!

Zest Tea (Lemon & Ginger)

Zest Tea is a delicate and refreshing infusion of lemongrass, real ginger and lemon pieces which combine superbly well to produce a well balanced and zesty flavour which will calm and soothe the senses. This tea is also believed to be a good tonic for the digestive system.

Sleep Well Tea

Franklin Bespoke Breakfast Tea

This English Breakfast is a blend of Assam, Ceylon, Darjeeling, Kenyan and Keemun teas, which produces a lovely full-bodied tea with a coppery infusion with hints of flowery sweetness, muscatel and spiciness.

Earl Grey Tea

Earl Grey is one of the most widely drunk teas in the world. Its distinct flavour is a result of combining high quality Chinese black tea and oil of bergamot, originally used to protect the flavour from mould and tar during long sea voyages. This beautifully scented tea with its flowery and citrusy flavour remains the embodiment of the finest English tea.

Darjeeling Goomtee

Goomtees ranked among the top gardens in the Darjeeling district, India and produces luscious green leaves with hues ranging from oaky-brown to light green. This tea offers a deliciously light, smooth and refreshing cup with distinctive muscatel characteristics and hints of citrus.

Franklin Afternoon Bespoke Tea

This wonderful Afternoon tea is medium bodied black tea ideally drunk between 2pm and 8pm. It is a blend of decadent earl grey laced with the sweetness from oolong tea and finished with English rose petals.
